Cheese and spinach triangles with a pesto condiment.

Spinach, mint, parsley and thyme was harvested from the school garden. Firstly the spinach was shredded, feta was cut up and mixed with the spinach and herbs. Seth prepared the filo pastry with butter. The triangles were folded with ingredients and some parmesan cheese on top. The pesto was made using peas, mint, crushed pine nuts and oil.
