Student of the Week

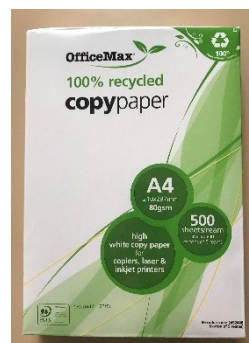
