Hot Lunch

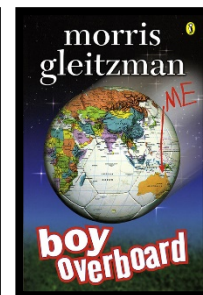
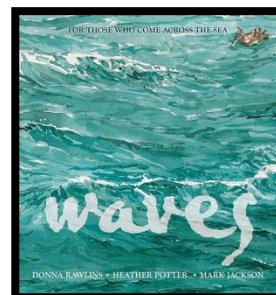
