Special Swimming and Water Safety Scheme

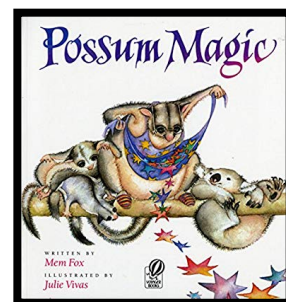

Student of the Week

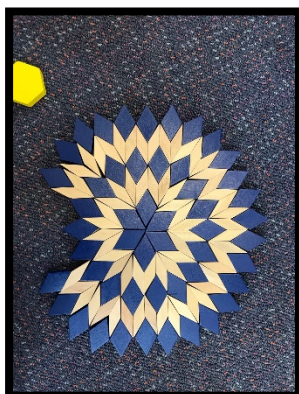
