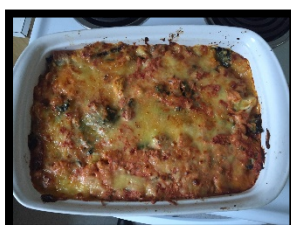

### Hot Lunch Finale

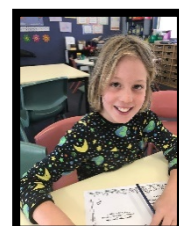
