Learning Activities to Start the Year

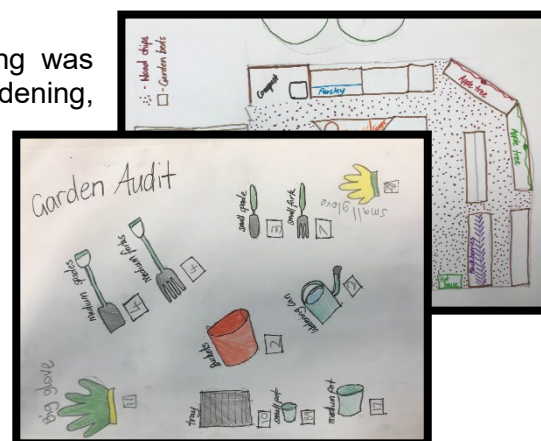
We have enjoyed a number of learning activities including creatively making our own book covers. Making book covers has been a lot of fun and a quiet settled activity to transition into the school year. Our book covers look fantastic and play an important part in taking pride in the presentation of our learning and encourage children to continue to put in their best effort everyday.



We began measurement lessons by talking about the terms, shorter and taller, we created a class of paper shadows, measured ourselves and objects around the room using formal and informal units. Comparisons and clarification was made

and a developing understanding that units of measurements need to be consistently the same size with no gaps or overlap for a true and accurate measurement.

Garden mapping and auditing was where we began with gardening, estimating proportions by relating different objects in the garden, discussing mapping methods, use of keys or legends and symbols. Encouraging again, a high level of presentation.
